Below, you will find our updated supply list\* for this coming school year. **Parents, please send ONLY the items listed below, preferably on the morning of the first day of school.** Any items you wish to recycle from last year would be fine. - 2 Dozen Pre-sharpened Pencils**, boxed or rubber-banded together with your child's name attached to the bundle. No mechanical pencils please. (These pencils will be stored in class to be used sparingly.)
- 1 Box of Crayola Brand Crayons** (48 or 64 count are plenty)
- 3 or 4 Pink Block Erasers**
- 1 Fisker's Brand Pointed Scissors** (Be sure to get right or left handed scissors depending on which type your child needs.)
- 1 Elmer's Brand White Liquid Glue**
- 5 to 8 Elmer's Glue Sticks**
- 2 Wide-Rule Composition Notebooks/Journals** (any color cover)
- 1 Pack of White Printer Copy Paper** (500 sheets)
- 1 Plastic Supply Box** (approx. 5" x 8" x 2" ... This box will house your child's crayons. If you want, you can put the crayons inside supply box and throw away the crayon box.)
- 1 Large Sturdy Zipper Bag** (These are usually canvas made for pencils ... most have 3 punch holes for notebook storage. This bag will house your child's extra pink erasers, scissors, glue sticks, and liquid glue.)
- 1 Large Box of Facial Tissue**, to be shared with class
- 1 Large Container of Disinfectant Wipes**, to be shared
- 2 Boxes of Plastic Forks**
- 2 Boxes of Plastic Spoons**

(Off-brand supplies make a big difference. Cheaper crayons, scissors, and glue sticks are ESP inferior in quality.)

\*Please come in our class and check periodically during the year to see what supplies your child may be low on. I try to send notes regarding this as well.
