



## Dress Code

### Bottoms

- ✓ All bottoms (pants, shorts, capris, and jumpers) need to be navy, black, or khaki.
- ✓ Shorts should NOT be shorter than fingertip length (with arms down by side). Skirts and jumpers are not to be shorter than 3 inches above the knee. (In order to get proper length, purchase age appropriate sizes and alter if necessary).
- ✓ Uniform and cargo style (pockets/zippers on the sides) pants, shorts, capris, or skirts ARE allowed.\*
- ✓ Any uniform plaid skirt or jumper is allowed.
- ✓ Pants should **not** be form fitting to the body. (**ex. leggings or jeggings are not allowed**)

### Shirts

- ✓ Polo shirts must be uniform style (no fitted or short polos). Any color is allowed.
- ✓ Shirts may or may not be worn tucked in.\*
- ✓ If a student chooses to wear a t-shirt under the polo, it must be white or a solid color, & not show below the bottom of the polo if worn untucked.
- ✓ All solid color uniform type polos are acceptable (NO logos).
- ✓ Any color turtleneck may be worn (NO logos).
- ✓ DTD sweatshirts/hoodies may be worn in class. (These are referred to as Patriotwear.)
- ✓ Sweaters and vests may be navy, white, or red.

### Socks/Tights

- ✓ Any color socks are acceptable. Solid navy, white, khaki, or red tights may be worn.

### Belts/Shoes

- ✓ Belts are not required unless pants are loose fitting and need a belt to fit properly.\*
- ✓ All students must wear close-toed shoes. Being a safety issue, this is mandated by the Potomac Conference. Students are NOT allowed to wear open toe sandals or flip flops.

### Hair/Skin/Nails

- ✓ Hair should be well groomed. Distracting hairstyles or unnatural colors/tints/highlights are not allowed.
- ✓ Temporary or permanent tattoos and body graffiti are NOT allowed.
- ✓ Any color fingernail polish is permitted, with the exception of black.

### Jewelry

- ✓ Jewelry (including rubber bands, wristbands, and friendship bracelets) are not to be worn to school.
- ✓ Students may not wear earrings, plastic hole-savers, or wear any type of cover over earrings. Please do not allow your child to get his/her ears pierced during the school year, as they will not be able to heal properly.

### Other Uniform Guidelines

- ✓ All school clothing should be clean and in new to good condition.
- ✓ Ball caps, visors, beanies, and bandanas are not to be worn except for special announced events. These are not permitted to be worn in any worship service.
- ✓ All casual day clothing should be clean, without holes, modest, with pictures and wording in keeping with Christian values.
- ✓ Coats, jackets, hoodies, and sweatshirts other than DTD uniform sweatshirts must be hung up or put in lockers before school begins. If students are cold in class they need to wear a DTD sweatshirt (Patriotwear) or a uniform sweater. School sweatshirts/hoodies may be ordered in the fall. Please watch for Patriotwear an order form in August.
