Welcome to our class, all new and returning students! Below you will find my updated supply list. **Please send ONLY the items listed below, preferably on the morning of the first day of school.** Any items you wish to recycle from last year would be fine. - 1 pair of comfy headphones or wired ear buds** (Please send these to school in a clear zip bag with your child's name on the bag.)
- 2 Dozen Pre-Sharpended Pencils** (In their original package is fine. No mechanical pencils please. These pencils will be stored to be used sparingly.)
- 1 Box of Crayons** (48 is plenty/64 is too many)
- 1 Box of 10 Classic Colors, Broad Line, Washable Markers**
- 3 or 4 Pink Block Erasers**
- 1 Fisker's Brand Pointed Scissors** (Be sure to get right or left-handed scissors depending on which type your child needs. Also, if your child has a large hand you may want to choose large kid-size scissors.)
- 1 Bottle Elmer's Brand White Liquid Glue**
- 4 Glue Sticks**
- 2 Wide-Rule, Bound Composition Notebooks** (Not spiral bound please.)
- 1 Pack of Wide-Rule Lined Notebook Paper** (I have plenty of copy paper.)
- 1 Plastic Supply Box** (approx. 5"x 8"x 2 This box will house your child's crayons. If you want to help you can put the crayons inside this supply box and throw away the original crayon box.)
- 1 Large Sturdy Zipper Bag** (Usually canvas not plastic. These usually have 3 punch holes for binder storage. This bag will need to be large enough to house your child's pink erasers, scissors, glue sticks, and liquid glue. Feel free to open the items and stow them in the large zipper bag for us!)
- 2 Large Boxes of Facial Tissue** (To be shared.)
- 1 Large Bottle of Spray Disinfectant** (To be shared.)
- 1 Box of Band-Aids** (To be shared.)
- 1 Package of Uncoated 9" White Paper Plates** (To be shared at lunch.)
- 1 Package of Cheap Napkins** (To be shared at lunch.)
- Please send a leak proof water bottle with water every day**
