Welcome to our class, all new and returning students! Below you will find my updated supply list. Please send ONLY the items listed below, preferably on the morning of the first day of school. Any items you wish to recycle from last year would be fine. Feel free to contact me if you have any questions @ 434-660-1130. See you soon! Love, Ms. Jeannie

- **1 pair of comfy headphones for daily use, important** (Please send these to school in a clear zip bag with your child's name on the bag.)
- **2 Dozen PRE-SHARPENED Pencils**, boxed (In their original package is fine. No mechanical pencils please. These pencils will be stored to be used sparingly. Several returning students from last year have pencils leftover stored in class.)

1 Box of Crayons (Gently used from last year **48** is plenty.)

- **3** or 4 Pink Block Erasers
- **1 Fisker's Brand <u>Pointed</u> Scissors** (Be sure to get right or left-handed scissors depending on which type your child needs. Also, if your child has a large hand you may want to choose large kid-size scissors. If not too small, reusing last year's pair is a good idea!)

1 Elmer's Brand WHITE Liquid Glue

- 4 to 6 Glue Sticks
- **2 Wide-Rule, Bound Composition Notebooks** (Not spiral bound please.)
- 1 Reem of Copy Paper or 1 Pack White Cardstock Paper, your choice
- □ 1 PLASTIC Supply Box (approx. 5" x 8" x 2" This box will house your child's crayons. If you want to help you can put the crayons inside this supply box and throw away the original crayon box.)

1 Large Sturdy Canvas Zipper Bag (Not plastic please. These usually have 3 punch holes for binder storage. This bag will need to be large enough to house your child's pink erasers, scissors, glue sticks, and liquid glue. Feel free to open the items and stow them in the large zipper bag for us!)

- **2 Large Boxes of Facial Tissue** (To be shared with the class.)
- 1 Large Bottle of Germ Kill Cleaning Spray Solution (To be used with a washcloth to clean desks after lunch, etc.)
- Please send a clean water bottle with fresh water daily. I will remind the kids to put these in their backpacks at the end of the day to go home to be washed
