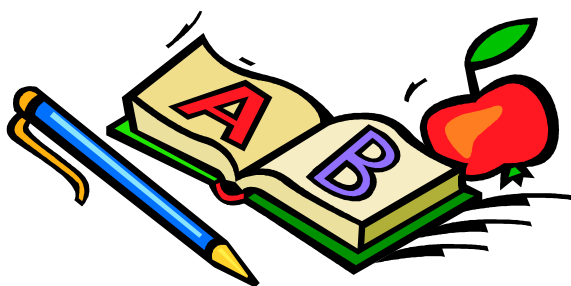


Fantastic Opportunity to Obtain a Scholarship!

**Introducing the Virginia Education Improvement Scholarships
Tax Credits Program through the Potomac Conference Education Foundation**



This program offers qualifying Virginia families the opportunity to send their children to a Virginia Seventh-day Adventist school of their choice using private scholarships!

Students are encouraged to apply for a Tax Credits Scholarship if

- They are Virginia residents,
- Meet the family income requirements,
AND
- They are eligible to enter kindergarten or first grade, **OR**
- They attended a Virginia public school for at least one semester in the current year, or during the preceding year they attended a public school for at least one-half of the year, **OR**
- They are a prior recipient of a Virginia tax credits scholarship

Students currently attending a non-public Virginia school, or homeschooling, do not qualify unless they are a prior recipient of this scholarship.

You are eligible to apply provided you have a family income of less than 300% of poverty or, in the case of a student with a disability, a family income of less than 400% of poverty.

Income Guidelines for VA Tax Credits Scholarships recipients for the 2025-2026 school year, are contained in the chart below (based on 2023 income).

Scholarship amounts are capped by the amount of the state share of public education spending in the county where the child resides.

The Potomac Conference Education Foundation may provide less than this amount and each specific school will determine the scholarship amount based on individual need, available scholarship funds, and other school-based assistance.
